

# Accreditation of Competence in E-Safety

An age appropriate e-safety programme of classroom activities to help children develop their skills and confidence in the digital world.



From September 2014, how will you meet the requirements to ensure children are safe, responsible, competent, confident and creative users of technology?

We need our children to have experience of the world as it is, and increasingly in terms of their use of technology that includes the online world. We know that even very young children are accessing the Internet regularly and just as in the real world, we want to help children to be risk aware so that they can learn how to take appropriate actions.

The Elearning Team at The ICT Service have created 'ACE', an age appropriate programme of activities designed to encourage primary school children to practice their online skills, document what they do online and be rewarded when they show that they can keep themselves safe in the online world.

The scheme consists of background information, teaching suggestions, resources and web-links, tasks for the children to complete, passports to monitor progress and achievement certificates.
